To help the individuals and the society through education to become conscious collaborator in the process of 'TRANSFORMATION OF THE CONSCIOUSNESS'.




Mission:



Action:

Sri Aurobindo Centre for New Education follows an integrated curriculum that nurtures deepest human aspiration in each learner based on time-tested, multifaceted Indian culture, that fosters the spirit of mutual dependence, mutual respect, enlightened parenting and global outlook, leading to actualise a new possibility.





Location

Sri Aurobindo Centre for New Education, is sprawled over 5 acres of land, planted with numerous trees and landscaped with expanses of flowering shrubs and greenery. The school buildings are nestled amongst trees and are surrounded by lawns. The composite stone masonry blend with the rustic feels of the surrounding hills. The designs adopted and the materials used make the facilities climate-sensitive. The existing biodiversity will provide soothing thermal insulation against the tropical summers. The class rooms and all other facilities are naturally well-lit and well ventilated. The school extensively uses solar energy promoting sustainable developmental goals.

The school is affiliated to the CBSE (Central Board of Secondary Education), in the year 2011. The affiliation number is 1730460.



Classes 11 and 12

From July 2011, we have commenced Class 11. We offer all the three streams – Science, Humanities and Commerce – with a liberal choice of optional subjects as per the NEP 2020 and NCF 2022 and 2023.

Medium of Learning

As required by the CBSE, the medium of instruction is English. Hindi is offered as second language and Sanskrit as the third language and are integral to the curriculum.

Teacher Student Ratio

Sri Aurobindo Centre for New Education (SACNE) is committed to keeping an optimally low learner-teacher ratio. Each class has a maximum strength of 25 learners. SACNE emphasises student teacher ratio to 1:10 for facilitating meaningful learning and individualised care for each student.

Academic Sessions

Sri Aurobindo Centre for New Education is a summer bound school: It functions in the following schedule.

1st Term: 1st week of April to late October

2nd Term: Mid November to Mid-March

The Learning Programme

Sri Aurobindo's vision of education is a new education that is uniquely suited to the Indian mind and temperament and human beings as a whole, one that provides educational excellence and an opportunity for the child to know and express the inner self, that allows him/her to grow at their own pace and reach the highest potential.

The Three Principles of Education by Sri Aurobindo That We Practice

The first principle of true teaching is that **nothing can be taught**. The teacher is not an instructor or task master; he is a **helper and a guide**. His business is to suggest and not to impose. He does not actually train the pupil's mind; he **only shows him how to perfect his instruments of knowledge** and helps and encourages him in the process. He does not impart knowledge to him; he **shows him how to acquire knowledge for himself**. He does not call forth the knowledge that is within; he only shows him where it lies and how it can be habituated to rise to the surface.

The second principle is that **the mind has to be consulted in its own growth**. The idea of hammering the child into the shape desired by the parent or teacher is a **barbarous and ignorant superstition**. It is he himself who must be induced to expand in accordance with his own nature. The account, the arrangement predetermined, the fixed ideal, notion or method, the prearranged career — to force the nature to abandon its own dharma is to do permanent harm.

The third principle of education is to **work from the near to the far**. Nature teaches us that **a child's mind must grow** from what is **near, immediate and familiar**, to what is more remote. The best method is to draw out the child's powers and capacities through the immediate surroundings, the soil from which he draws sustenance, the air he breathes, his home, his country, his past. These form the natural basis on which he grows. We must not force the child's most powerful habits prematurely. The mind must be allowed to grow **naturally**, in its own time and season. From the known to the unknown — from near to far — from that which is, to that which shall be. Ideas, images, impressions must not be forced unnaturally from outside; a free and natural growth is the condition of genuine development.

Currently school education has largely been preoccupied by mental learning and training of the intellect. But true education in the light of the Sri Aurobindo and The Mother must have five essential aspects relating to the principal activities of the human being, that is; the physical (Annamaya Kosha -the body), the vital (Pranayama kosha or the emotional nature) the mental (the Manomaya kosha or the mind) the psychic (the Vigyanamaya Kosha- Soul principle) and the spiritual (Anandamaya Kosha). This kind of education is named as fivefold education corresponding to the five principal beings.

The educational precepts of Sri Aurobindo and The Mother serve as the foundation even from the Nursery. We begin the education of Sanskrit from Pre-primary classes through stories and chanting shlokas.

Following goals are set which is worked on by experienced and skilled educators.

- To help students to achieve highest academic pinnacle through well thought out rigorous process.
- Sri Aurobindo Centre for New Education provides an environment for children to learn critical skills that will help them lead a meaningful life.
- To be able to make sense of unfamiliar situations and respond to them effectively.
- To be aware of themselves, the reasons for their behaviour and their relationship to the world around them
- To communicate effectively with the world around them.
- To learn to cooperate, live and work together
- To treat the surrounding community as a significant source of learning opportunities
- To place importance on silence and introspection
- To encourage the spirit of learning to live with less
- To work for Sustainable Developmental Goals.
- To become aware and engage consciously in inquiry about oneself.

Arts & Crafts

At SACNE, Arts and Crafts form part of the curriculum on par with other subjects. Timetable allots block periods for arts and crafts to ensure adequate time for related activities. Eight fine arts and performing art teachers from drawing, painting, pottery, dance (kathak and Bharat Natyam) batik, hand paper making, theatre in education etc. take classes and hone the basic skills and help students to develop a refined sense of aesthetics. Workshops led by experts in different art forms are held every week. The relative perfection in the different art and craft work is presented before the parents during PTM, to the peer group and to other classes time to time.

Students put up impressive exhibitions of their work as part of celebrations during ART MELA, Subject learning Display, and at the Sports meet. Indeed, the SACNE campus by itself is an open-air multimedia/ botanical sculpture museum. The animal sculptures are not merely objects for display; they also connote alertness, speed, concentration, balance, harmony, team spirit etc.



Music, Dance and Theatre

Training is imparted to all the interested children in Hindustani Music with the required accompanying instruments such as synthesiser, guitar, tabla and flute. A weekly morning assembly at SACNE filled with chanting and singing. SACNE teaches different forms of dance that includes even folk dance. Children learn local folk dances with the help of external faculty and perform in full costume on festive occasions.

Sports and Games

SACNE lays great stress on the physical development of children. Half an hour in the morning is set apart for P.T., Yoga, Football, basketball, cricket, Badminton, Table tennis, volleyball, kabaddi, kho-kho, Malkham, Skating, Karate and athletics are regularly played on the campus. Children also play carom and chess.

It is critical that parents and teachers both reinforce the spirit of enquiry in a child. Parents should also ensure that the cultural complements imparted at the school are reinforced during the holidays. At no stage should they be in conflict.

We provide opportunities for parents to interact with the school. These will take the form of dialogues, workshops and seminars to ensure that a high level of communication exists between the two and that feedback in either direction is timely and constructive.



In keeping with our ethos, residences are extended learning spaces. They provide opportunities for children to share experiences, live and work together, engage with adults and take responsibility for themselves.
